### Public Transport

How do I get to Albany Tennis Centre from Central Auckland?

**Please note:** The Albany Loop is a special service provided for World Masters Games 2017 participants by Auckland Transport and will not appear in the AT Journey Planner. This service also includes a stop at North Harbour Stadium.

If you have a **Bronze** registration package the Albany Loop will cost \$5 for a return trip (no single fare available). Please ensure you have cash as these buses will not accept AT HOP cards. Keep your ticket so you do not have to pay again on your return.

If you have a **Silver or Gold** registration package you can use the Albany Loop free of charge by showing your Games accreditation as you board.

## What time does the Albany Loop start and finish?

The Albany Loop starts at 6:30am every day except ANZAC Day when it will start at 10:30am. The Albany Loop finishes each day at 10pm except 30 April when it finishes at 5pm. Please note: the Albany Loop will not be running on 21 April so if you are attending the matching day you will need to plan your journey using the AT Journey Planner.

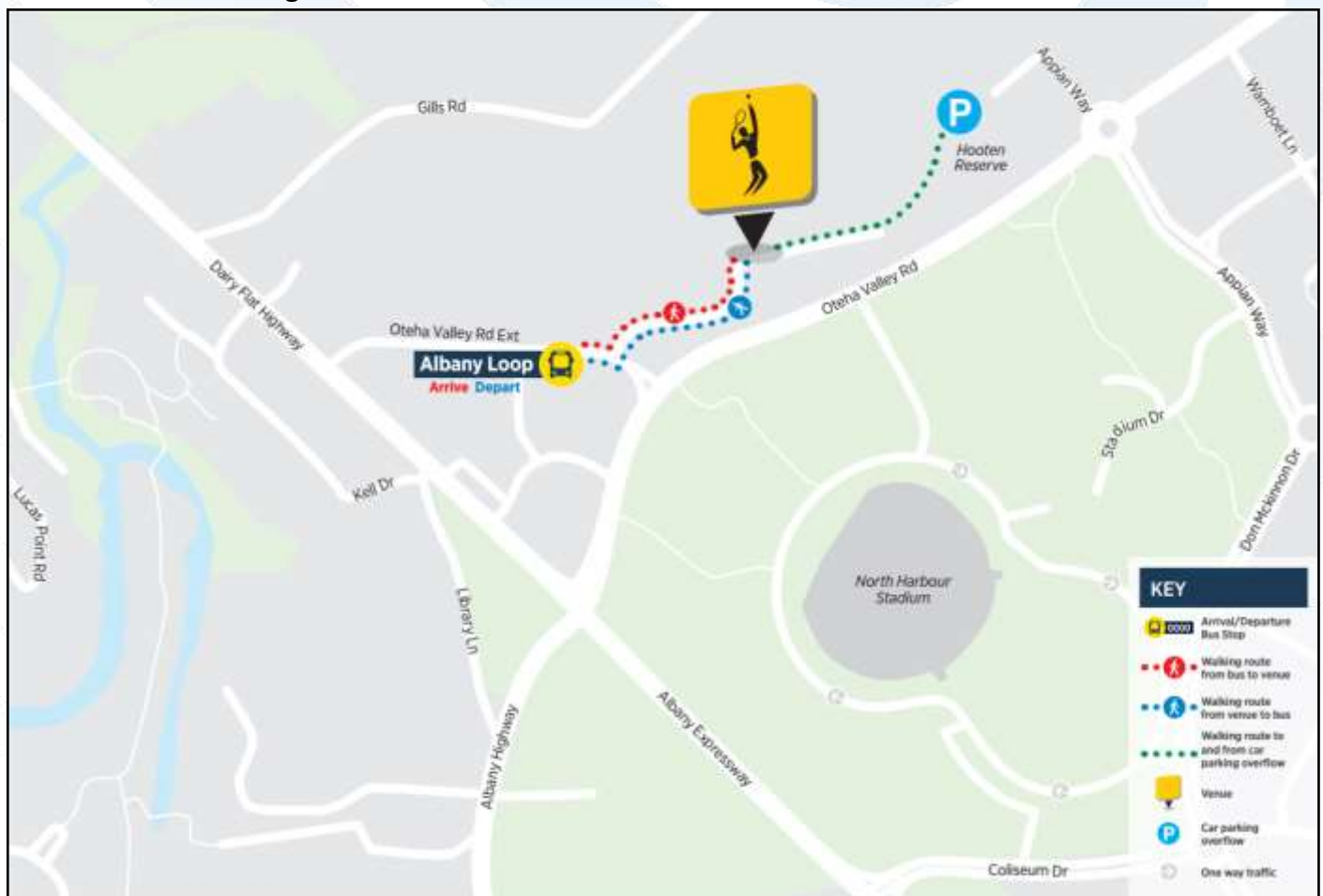
## What time does the NEX start and finish?

## Travelling with sports equipment

Sports equipment can be taken on public transport. However, if a bus is full drivers have the right to ask you to wait for the next bus if they think you and your equipment cannot be safely transported on the bus.

## Parking

Parking for tennis participants, supporters and public is at Hooton Reserve Carpark 1 on Oteha Valley Road. This is accessed at the roundabout at the Oteha Valley Road / Appian Way intersection. There will be signs on Oteha Valley Road showing the entrance to the tennis parking and from Hooton Reserve to court 6.

Access to the Albany Tennis Centre carpark off Oteha Valley Road Extension is for vehicles with an official WMG Tennis carpark sticker only. Access is restricted to officials, World Masters Games 2017 personnel, emergency and maintenance vehicles.

## Important Information

Please allow plenty of time to get to your venue if you are using public transport or driving. Failing to turn up to your match/ event on time could result in disqualification.

Please note a transfer could add additional time to your journey - plan accordingly.

If you are using an AT HOP card please remember to tag on and tag off on buses and trains. Failure to tag off will result in a penalty fare.
